Educational Surrogate Parent (ESP) Training for Foster Parents Who Are (or may be) Caring for Children who have Special Education Needs

AND

Community Volunteers Interested in Serving as Educational Surrogate Parents

An Educational Surrogate Parent is an individual who is appointed by the Delaware Dept. of Education to protect the parental special education rights of a child who has a disability and is receiving special education services. This training will include information about the role and responsibilities of an ESP, together with information about the special education process and working with a school team to develop an Individualized Education Program (IEP). A certificate will be provided after participation in the training and an appointment letter will follow for those who are appointed as the ESP for a child. To stay active as an ESP, training is required on an annual basis.
